WHAT THE SYMBOLS ON THE MAP MEAN

Timepoints are places the bus is scheduled to reach at a specific time (listed on the schedule). The timepoints are not the only places the bus will stop along the route.

Transfer Points show connections with other bus routes. The connecting route letter is in the box. This is an example of where to transfer to the "J" route.

925 AND 928 EXPRESS

CTtransit Express Route 925 and Route 928 are a new routes linking Waterbury, Cheshire, Southington, New Britain & Hartford. Route 925 & 928 buses make the following stops in greater Waterbury:

- Waterbury Railroad Station (connection to Metro-North Waterbury Branch)
- Field & Grand Streets at Waterbury City Hall
- Meadow Street at Waterbury Superior Court
- West Main Street at Waterbury Green (Exchange Place; connection to CTtransit Waterbury local routes)
- East Main Street at UConn Waterbury
- South Elm Street at St. Mary's Hospital
- Waterbury/Hamilton Avenue Park & Ride (I-84 Exit 23)
- Cheshire/Route 70 Park & Ride (I-84 Exit 26)

The 925 route provides peak hour, weekday service. The 928 Express operates seven days a week.
